City Projects



Urban Contractors will start sewer line rehabilitation in April. The areas affected are:

- Stratford from Westminster to Dorchester Place
- 6400 Blk. of Pennsylvania
- 1700 and 1600 Blk. of Randal Rd.

Water line replacement in the southeast portion of the city has been completed. (Phase I)

Bond Projects:

Water lines

The City is currently replacing water lines from Avondale to Western and From Tedford to Wilshire (Phase II). The project contractor is Southwest Water Works and the project should be completed by August 1, 2006.

Sewer Lines

The is currently awaiting proposals for a new Document Imaging System. A Document Imaging System allows for scanning of paper documents that previously were kept in file cabinets into a computer system for storage, indexing and easy retrieval. The City has been interested in such a project for about ten years but over the past several years the price of imaging systems have come down enough to make it affordable for the city. The city

has budgeted funds in the current fiscal year budget to purchase such a system. A committee of city employees representing City Administration, Public Works Department, Police Department, and the Fire Department has been charged by City Manager David Poole to prepare the requests for proposals, review proposals after they are received, develop an implementation plan for the entire city, and make a recommendation to the City Council regarding which system will best fit the needs of the City. Proposals are due to be received by April 17, 2006. The review process will then begin. The target date for purchase of the Document Imaging System is June 30. The City hopes to have the system online and running in all City Departments by January 1, 2007.

Tips:

As storm season approaches here are a few items to consider:

THE CITY OF NICHOLS HILLS DOES **NOT** HAVE A PUBLIC STORM SHELTER!

Know what to do in case of severe weather - plan and practice a tornado drill at home with your family.

If you have a storm shelter/safe room make sure it is accessible and cleaned out.

If you have a large enough storm shelter or shelter/safe room and

don't mind sharing, let your neighbors know. Some items that you should have in your shelter include but are not limited to:

- a flashlight
- a portable radio or weather radio
- extra batteries (for the flashlight and radio)
- a first-aid kit
- blankets
- snacks
- Water
- cell phone

~ You can register your storm shelter/safe room with the Nichols Hills Fire Department by calling 843-8526 M-F 8:00am-4:30pm. By doing this it will help us know where to look in a weather emergency.


